- 2. Elizabeth Saunders, Treasurer, not present No detailed financials reviewed

New Actions from February meeting

- 1) Committee Chairs to write 3 Aims/Objectives for their team goal for 2019. To reflect Executives goals which where communicated in January & February BoD meetings
 - a. clarifying and documenting chapter charters,
 - b. membership growth and member activation/participation,
 - c. financial empowerment of committee's.
- 2) Bob T's call for volunteers to assist with 2019 Golf tournament
- 3) Jays ask about holding potential 2nd Poker Tournament in the north region of seattle. Survey data to collect interest and Sponsorship goals to tie into this as a 2019 goal
- 4) Robert reviewed the proposed budget for CFM week long training. Board approved his plans for the date and proposed costs.
- 5) Board agreed that we will make a path for student memberships at no-cost to students
 - a. Board to issue a letter to IFMA Central to raise the issue and our plans to address it
 - b. David L to check with other chapters to asses other if other solutions are in place
- 6) Board confirmed that one student scholarship would be available this year for World Workplace attendance.
- 7) Board agreed fee ranges for use of Museum of Flight conference rooms. Initially offering \$100.
